YOUR I.D.

(Drivers license OR passport or – **this is vital!**)

You cannot get into a nightclub in Newquay without ID, nor will you receive your event wristband. **SO DON'T FORGET IT.** The Holiday Park also run a strict Under 21 policy in the bar/supermarket so anyone who appears to be under 21 must show ID in the form of a passport or driving license to prove they are 18 or over.

OUTGOING

GETTING TO SUMMER BREAK

VIA OWN TRANSPORT

Many of you this year are making your own way to Summer Break, so please remember that the roads in and around Newquay can be very narrow with limited passing places so take care. Drive carefully and ensure BOTH YOU & YOUR PASSENGERS are wearing their seatbelts.

We work very closely with the local authorities and the Police who are aware that this is arrival day and will be on patrol. Make sure you are strapped in and adhering to the national speed limits that apply.

DO NOT PUT THE TRELVEGUE POST CODE INTO YOUR SAT NAV

It will result in you being taken around the unmarked narrow Cornish lanes. If you are going to use Sat Nav, then aim for **PORTH, Cornwall**.

DIRECTIONS

- At Junction 31 of the M5, exit onto A30 – direction OKEHAMPTON/BODMIN
- Take the A39 exit toward INDIAN QUEENS / ST DENNIS/ NEWQUAY
- At HIGHGATE HILL ROUNDABOUT, take the 3rd onto A39
- At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit onto A392
- At the Roundabout in Quintrel Downs take the 3rd Exit onto the A3058
- Proceed for 2 miles Before taking the 2nd exit onto B3276/ Porth way
- Continue for 0.5 mile past the beach and up the hill
- Then turn RIGHT down Trevelgue Road
- Continue for 500 metres then Park in the Nightclub Park on the RIGHT.
- Please Note: Look out for Summer Break signs directing you at these points.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE / CHECK IN TIMES

No Keys Will Be Issued Before 12.00 midday – please do not rock up before this time – as you will be told to come back at the designated time. If you are early, take time to check out Newquay and the great beaches.

- If you are travelling with your Lead Passenger / Caravan Leader your check in is detailed below.
- If you are travelling separately from your group leader and they arrive before you, simply arrange to meet up with them to collect your caravan key / tent pitch id and event information from them, so you will need to stay in touch.
- If you arrive at the resort earlier than your group leader please wait for them before trying to check-in, as **caravan keys / tent pitch id will only be issued to the Lead Passenger.**

GETTING TO YOUR CARAVAN ON TREVELGUE

Caravans on Trevelgue / Smugglers - Unload your luggage from your coach in the main car park – **ENSURE YOU HAVE EVERYTHING WITH YOU!** Once your lead passenger has checked you in and collected all relevant info, you can make your way directly to your caravan on foot. **IF YOU CAN'T CARRY IT – DON'T PACK IT!**

Caravans in Smuggler's Haven – due to the restricted access of the site, coaches are unable to proceed to this area. Again, please make your way directly to your caravan by foot Campers on Trevelgue - All campers can proceed directly to their pitch once your lead passenger has checked you in and start setting up home!

ACCOMMODATION

Your accommodation is in spacious and comfortable 4/5/6/7 or 8 berth static caravans or camping if you have chosen that option. All caravans are equipped with fully fitted kitchens and cooking facilities. Please be aware that you may be required to share a double bed!!! It might just work in your favour at the end of the day...Facilities for the camping option includes toilet and shower blocks with electricity. Make sure you **pack your Sleeping Bag, Towel, Toilet Paper, Cleaning up Material and Tea Towels.**

ON SITE FACILITIES

Trevelgue has some great facilities, including an outdoor swimming pool, licensed restaurant, fish and chip shop, surf shop with surf board and bike hire, small supermarket/ off licence plus Waves bar and club, plus new dining outlets this year Herbies Diner, Shakin Shack, Paulies Pizza delivery service.

OUTGOING

CARAVAN INVENTORY / DAMAGE DEPOSITS

Upon booking you had two options: pay that pesky £50 on arrival in cash or via your booking beforehand.

If you selected option 1: pay £50 cash on arrival. You will need to have all the cash for your caravan ready to hand over upon check-in.

You will receive a receipt and the money will be paid back within 21 working days minus any deductions for damage.

Remember it is £50 a head and there are 2 cash machines on site, but recommend you get the money before from the litany of machines dotted in and around Newquay.

The lead passenger will be issued with a **Damage Report Form and Caravan Itinerary** (for caravans only). The purpose of the forms is for you to check on arrival that all is in order. One Damage Report Form is required per caravan. Please complete it before 9PM on the day of arrival and return it to the main reception. It will then be photocopied and a copy returned to you for your records.

Each caravan has an easy to follow inventory. If there is no inventory, ensure you make a note of this on the Damage Report Form. If you find anything broken, damaged, or missing, please note it down on the Damage Report Form. If this is not done, it will be assumed that any discrepancies found at the end of your stay were caused by you, and you will be charged to put them in order. **DON'T GET CAUGHT OUT** on this point... it's important that you check everything carefully when you get in!

VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

SHUTTLES

Summer Break will be operating bus shuttles from Trevelgue to Fistral in the morning, and back in the late afternoon, together with Newquay town centre in the evening and back in the early hours. If you haven't opted for the shuttle bus option and wish you had then you can purchase it for £15 (per person for the week) on arrival at check-in.

N.B. The internal shuttle saves you spending money on taxis and saves your legs from walking!!

This is not a regular bus service, its first come first served on jumping on a bus, so please bear this in mind when planning your day.

Should you wish to travel outside the noted times, then there is a regular bus service that drops outside Trevelgue plus a load of taxis are available.

PLEASE NOTE: The start of each activity lesson / session times (when the activity will start) will be emailed in addition to this. Summer Break attendees **MUST** attend the session noted as names have already been forwarded to the suppliers.

BEACHES

Summer Break has use of Fistral Beach during Summer Break. Please remember that it is the law that **NO ALCOHOL, GLASS OR BOTTLES WILL BE ALLOWED ONTO THE BEACH, YOUR BAGS WILL BE CHECKED BY BEACH SECURITY.** We have a very good relationship with Newquay Police and Council we do not want them to shut the party down. This does not mean you cannot drink at the beach... Fistral Beach and Summer Break has a licensed beach bar – they will be selling cool beers, and drinks at student friendly prices!

WRIST BANDS

Your Summer Break event wristbands, gives you access to all the fun, frolics and partying throughout Summer Break. Your wristband will be issued to you by one of your Summer Break reps, either on the Coach on the way to resort (if travelling by Summer Break Coach) or outside Waves Bar if travelling to Newquay by car. **Wristbands will be checked regularly – and there will be no entry to any of the venues including the beach without your Summer Break wristband.**

OUTGOING

WE WILL NOT SELL WRISTBANDS TO INDIVIDUALS –ANY FRIENDS THAT ARE THINKING OF COMING DOWN TO SUMMER BREAK WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRY TO THE CLUBS OR BEACH WITHOUT A PRE PURCHASED SUMMER BREAK HOLIDAY.

SUMMER BREAK EVENT OFFICE & MAIN RECEPTION

Your reps will be on hand for the duration of your stay to help out in any way they can!

The Summer Break Office will be located in caravan T4, opposite the Main Reception and the opening hours are as follows:

Opening Hours Everyday 0800hrs to 2100hrs

Plus the guys & gals at the Trelvelgue Holiday Park can answer any queries you may have in the absence of any Summer Break reps. After hours, the Holiday Park security can be located by the main entrance.

FIRST AID POINTS

There is one first aid point on the Trelvelgue site with qualified members of staff at hand to help: Caravan T3 – located behind the Summer Break Event Office. If you are struggling just find the nearest Summer Break rep and they will be more than happy to point you in the right direction.

There will also be a Paramedic on site outside Trelvelgue reception each night that can administer First Aid.

CARAVAN BEHAVIOUR AND SECURITY

Please secure your caravan when **departing or going out**. Ensure all windows are closed and all doors are locked. Please do not leave any valuables in the caravans unattended as **the park will not be liable for any losses**.

Please check your inventory list and check for any deficiencies or maintenance problems. Any problems or missing items must be reported to reception on the day of your arrival. Moderate noise will be tolerated only until 11pm. Any excessive noise after this time will result in **loss of behaviour deposits**. Anyone caught jumping over the fence between the parks will lose their behaviour deposits. Any persons found to be causing a nuisance, or impairing the enjoyment of other guests through bad language or misbehaviour will be removed from the site. Any breakages must be paid for in full by noon the following day. Please vacate your caravan by 10:00 on your day of departure. Lock all doors and close all windows.

Please be aware that if one person in your group/party is misbehaving or causing trouble in anyway – Trelvelgue reserves the right to remove every person in the caravan. So make sure you look after your friends and do not let them act irresponsibly – as the result will implicate everyone.

Please do not leave any valuables unattended as the park cannot be held liable for any losses.

BB guns, air horns, megaphones, knives and any other items/weapons we consider offensive are banned from site. If you are found to be in possession of such an item it will be confiscated and a disclaimer must be signed agreeing to its safe disposal. Refusal to sign this disclaimer may result in your eviction from site. Mini-motos are banned from site. Any found will be confiscated and may be collected on the day of departure.

We have a zero tolerance policy to all drugs and drug dealers. Anyone found with drugs on their possession will be evicted from site and their security bonds retained. Drug dealers will be handed straight to the police.

THEFT

If anyone is caught stealing while at Summer Break – the result will be instant removal from the site and includes everyone in your group/party. Damage deposits will also be lost for your entire group. This also includes the theft of any **branding, banners or inflatables** - Security Guards and Police will be patrolling the area regularly – so don't even think about it!

OUTGOING

DRIVING ON SITE

The speed limit on site is 5mph. Anyone found exceeding this limit will forfeit their behaviour deposit. Please be aware that a one way system will be in operation for the full duration of Summer Break.

AS YOU LEAVE THE STUDENT VILLAGE...

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE

On the day of departure, all caravans and camping pitches need to be vacated by **10AM**. Caravan checks by the Trevelgue Holiday Park staff will begin at 9AM. Your caravan must be left in the same clean condition as found upon arrival. **So don't forget to bring some cleaning materials!!!**

The following jobs should be completed before you leave:

-All washing up (including grill pan, etc.) done and put away. Rubbish bagged up and put into the wheelie bins situated throughout site. – **PLEASE ENSURE** that the area around your caravan is clean and all rubbish is dumped in the bins. All duvets and pillow cases stripped off and placed in lounge area. Surfaces should be clear.

Camping pitches need to be left spotless with all litter put in the bins provided.

COACH DEPARTURES

Coaches will be ready for loading at 09:00hrs from the SAME PLACE as where you were dropped off. (Information on coach lists and departure points will be available at reception). **MAKE SURE YOU KNOW WHEN YOU'RE DEPARTING!!**

The caravan/camping crew need to go directly to the coach and load-up by 09:00hrs.

The key holder needs to ensure all windows are closed and the exterior doors are locked and return the key to reception. The lead passenger can then join their coach and start thinking about Summer Break 2011!!

DRIVING HOME

Please be extremely careful on the roads when driving home – and please make sure that the designated person driving has absolutely **NO ALCOHOL** in their system.

A MESSAGE FROM CORNWALL AND DEVON POLICE

Whilst taking a break from University that you don't take a break from looking after yourself, your friends and your property and would like to offer a few simple tips and reminders.

Personal safety

Each year we receive reports of drinks being spiked. These reports are rare but the precautions you take at home still apply when on holiday. When in the pubs and clubs keep hold of your drinks at all times or make sure a friend is looking after it. Never leave drinks unattended in pubs and clubs. Cover the tops of bottles with your thumb.

Tell your friends if you are going home early, especially if it means leaving someone behind alone. Arrange to meet friends in a busy place and have an exact time to meet.

Property

Items such as mobile phones, digital cameras, ipods, cash, and credit cards are easily stolen if you leave them lying around unprotected. This includes in your accommodation. Give some thought to securing them if you have to leave them behind and never leave items unattended, whether on the beach during the day or out in the town in the evening.

OUTGOING

STAYING SAFE IN NEWQUAY

Don't jump the fence and stay out of that bush!

Please be very careful in and around Newquay town and **NEVER** jump over any fences or hedges. There are numerous sheer cliff drops right next to pavements and they are a long way down. If you see any of your friends jumping or climbing on fences please stop them **IMMEDIATELY**.

TRY AND REMEMBER THESE SAFETY TIPS WHEN OUT IN THE SUN:

- **Alcohol dehydrates you**, and the heat of the sun makes it worse. Pace yourself with water or a soft drink after every alcoholic drink.
- **Don't let drink lead you into risky situations**, like walking along a deserted cliff path at 2am.
- **Mixing drink with sports**, from volleyball to rock climbing, can lead to injuries. So play it safe. Likewise, midnight swimming and drinking is never advisable.
- **Carry a condom**, if you plan to possibly do more than kiss.
- **When you're relaxing in a beer garden**, on the beach or at a BBQ, lather on the sun lotion. A combination of hangover and sunburn is enough to spoil anyone's holiday.

ON YOUR NIGHTS OUT, REMEMBER:

- **Eat before you go out**, or during the evening
- **Drink water regularly** to stay refreshed and rehydrated.
- **Use soft drink spacers** to pace yourself - a tonic looks just the same as a vodka and tonic. A cola looks the same with or without the rum
- **Remember that too much drink will do nothing** for your looks - you're drop dead gorgeous until you drop down drunk
- **And don't succumb to the beer goggles effect** - you might think you've met your dream date - until the effect wears off
- **Don't accept drinks from strangers** and never leave your drink unattended - it's all too easy for someone to spike your drink
- **Finally, Look out for your friends** and make sure they look out for you.

IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY

In Case of Emergency (ICE) is a program that enables first responders, such as [paramedics](#), [fire-fighters](#), and [police officers](#), to contact the [next of kin](#) and obtain important medical information in extreme cases.

PLEASE ADD 'ICE' as a contact in your phone book and then place the **Next of Kin** contact number that can answer any important medical questions should urgent treatment is required.

BEACH SAFETY

KNOW YOUR FLAGS

On the beach it's important you know what each flag means:

Red & Yellow Flags: These show the lifeguarded area, the safest place to swim and bodyboard.

Black & White Chequered Flags: For surfboards, kayaks and other non-powered craft. Never swim or bodyboard here.

Red Flag: Danger! Never go in the water when the red flag is up, under any circumstances.

AVOIDING RIP TIDES:

Rips are strong currents that can quickly take swimmers from the shallows out beyond their depth. Lifeguards will show you where you can avoid rips but if you do get caught in one:

- Stay calm - don't panic.
- If you can stand, wade don't swim.
- Keep hold of your board or inflatable to help you float.
- Raise your hand and shout for help.
- Never try to swim directly against the rip or you'll get exhausted.
- Swim parallel to the beach until free of the rip, then make for shore.

If you see anyone else in trouble, alert the lifeguards or call **999** or **112** and ask for the Coastguard.

Missing Friends – When near the sea always be aware of where your friends are. If somebody has gone missing and was last seen near the sea contact the lifeguards **IMMEDIATELY**.
